




# Daily Sales vs. Goal





# **YTD Sales vs. Projection**






# **Rolling 12 Month Total Sales**














# **Draw Sales by Month**










# **Sales by Price Point - Scratcher and Pull Tabs**














# **Transfer Amount by Beneficiary**







# **FY25 Year-to-date Financial Status**




